Theo also made a model of the word 'Chicago'!



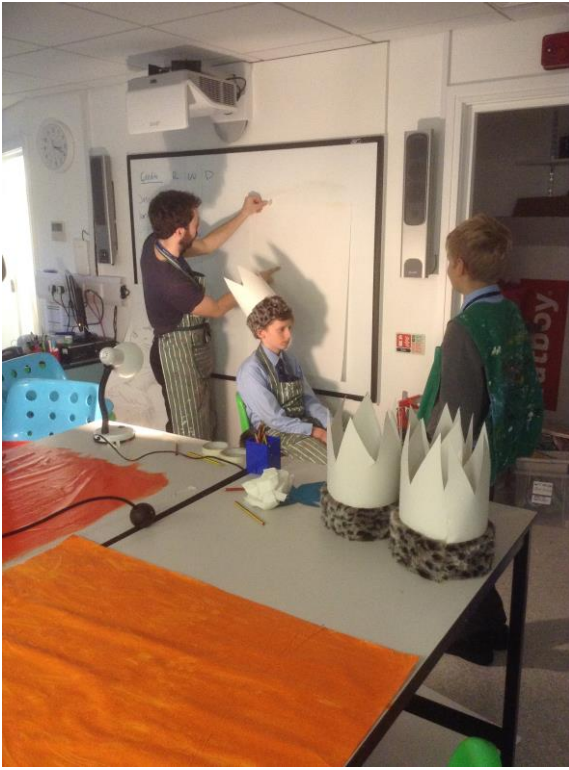
We also had plates of chocolate but as its Spanish we didn't add it to a group.

We created the museum as a visual memory. The pictures help us to remember.

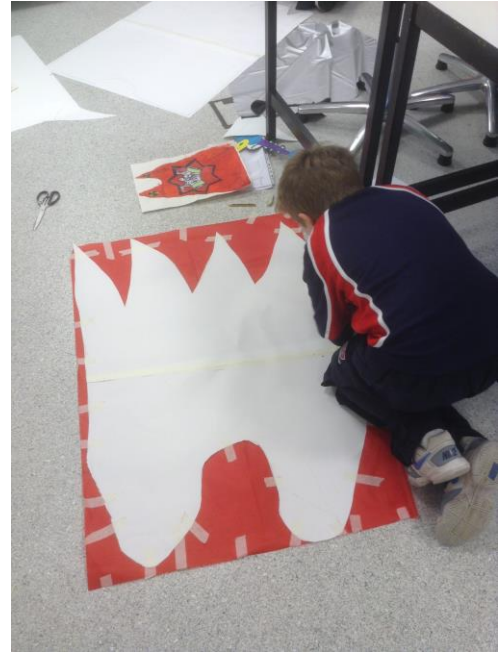

Year 11 have started studying Physics this week. They have been learning about the difference between heat and temperature recognising that energy flows from a hotter body to a cooler one.



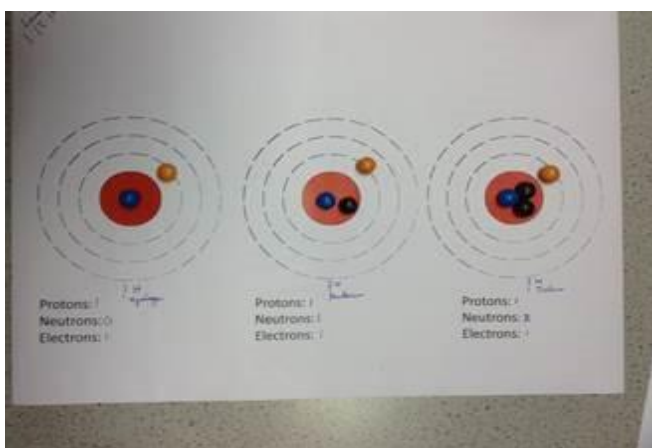
### PE – KS4
