## CS – Science – Yr 9

Y9 Science have been investigating how the size of a meteorite is related to the size of the crater it makes upon impact. In this experiment they have simulated a meteorite impact using different balls (table tennis ball and tennis ball) as meteorites and a tray of sand as the planet surface. The balls dropped in to the sand from different heights so they tested that the higher from which the ball is dropped, the bigger the diameter of the crater would be.
