CS – Visit to Parliament

The meeting included interesting information on plans by the DfE to set up literacy hubs in primary schools to help children learn to read if they were falling behind.

CS - Y9 have been observing the effects of smoking on the lungs. This demonstration should only be conducted in a fume cupboard and shows what happens when a cigarette is smoked. We set up the smoking machine in the fume cupboard using cotton wool and limewater + universal indicator. The cotton wool represented the human lungs and the solution was an indicator to test the acidity or alkalinity of the smoke. Our observations were that the cotton wool turned yellowish brown due to tar and the solution changed its colour due to carbon monoxide, sulphur dioxide and hydrogen cyanide present in the cigarette smoke.
