A copy of the card designs will be sent home and you will be able to order a pack of printed cards with your child's own design.



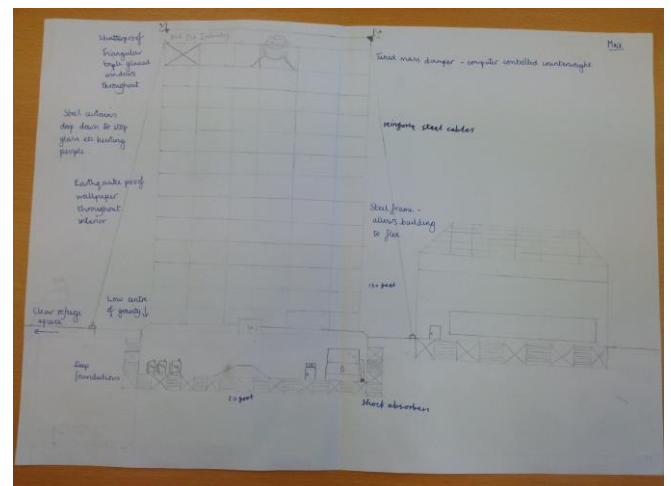
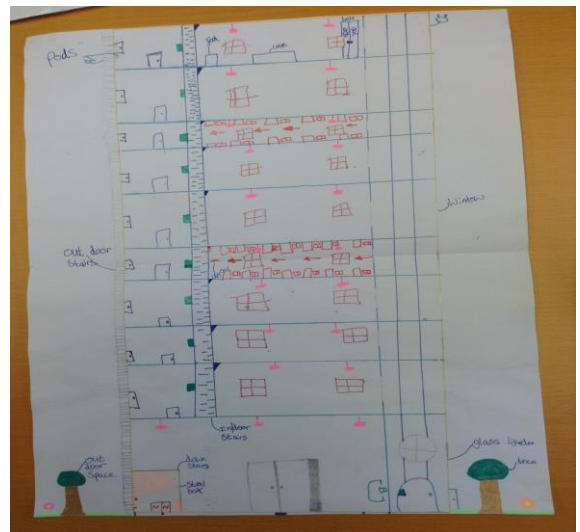
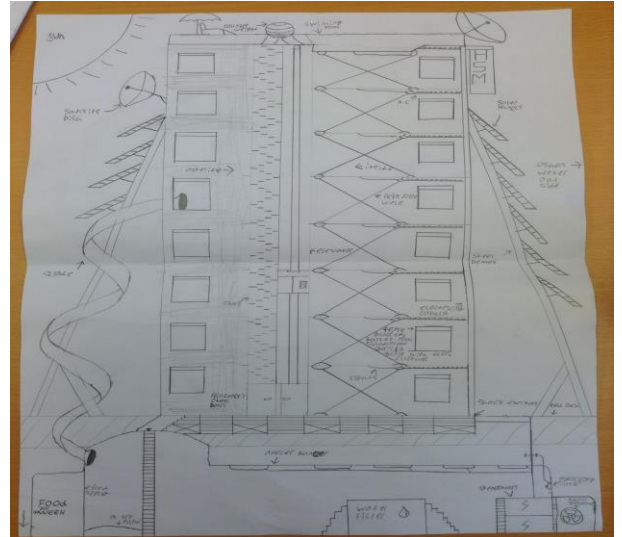
GEOGRAPHY – YEAR 10

KS4 Parents Evening

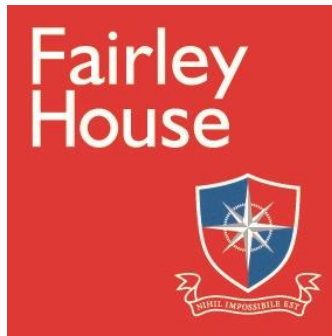
