What's been happening this week at Fairley House...

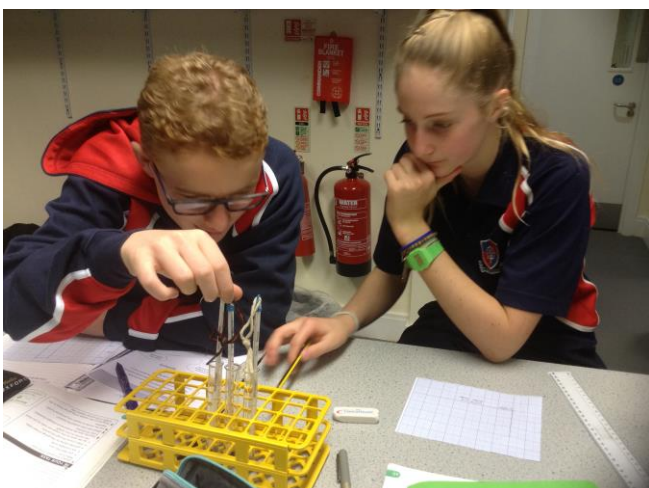
## KS3/KS4 SCIENCE

Before half term students safely carried out a food test for starch.



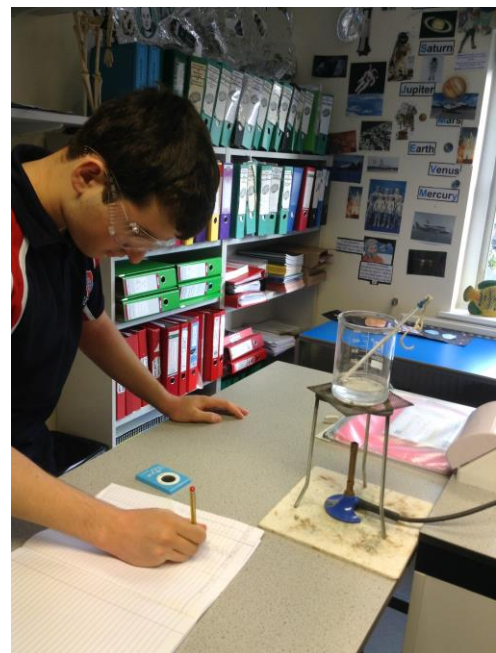
This week they have performed an experiment using a thermometer to accurately measure temperature and have plotted a bar chart to show their results.

Year 10 also heated ice and plotted a graph to show how the temperature changed.





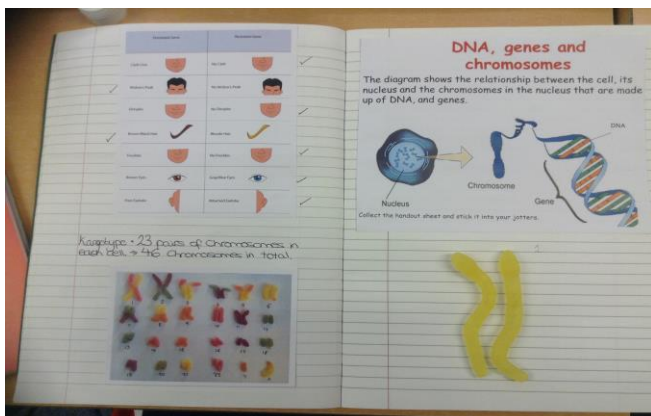
## **GEOGRAPHY – YEAR 6**

**Memory strategies: Remember it! Repeat it! Link it! Chunk it! Do it! Picture it!**

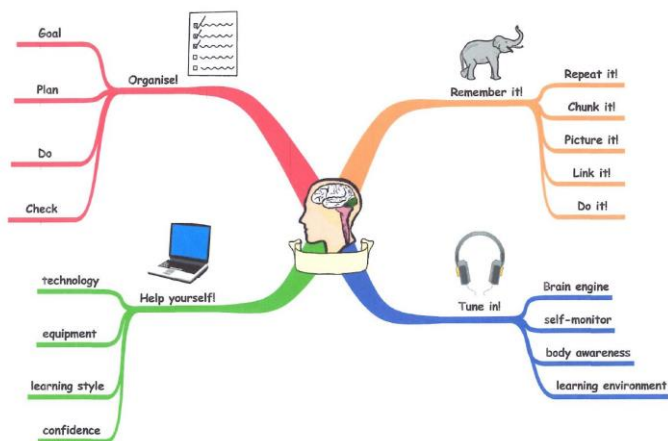
...and the second phase of the learning strategies, which is linked to attention, organization and independence.
