SCIENCE – MS UNAU

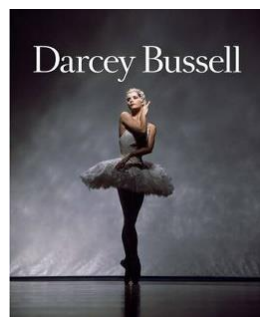
Year 9 have moved on to project based work in Science to prepare to help them develop their experimental skills in preparation for GCSE Science. This week they have been investigating the factors that affect plant growth.



Year 10 have been learning about the fractional distillation of crude oil. They used a molymod kit to represent molecules such as methane and to show how the atoms are rearranged to form carbon dioxide and water when hydrocarbons burn in oxygen.

Miss Bussell was a Principal dancer with the Royal Ballet Company for 20 years and is widely acclaimed as one of the great British ballerinas of our time.
