Year 4 Science – ‘Living Things & Their Habitat’ – LR

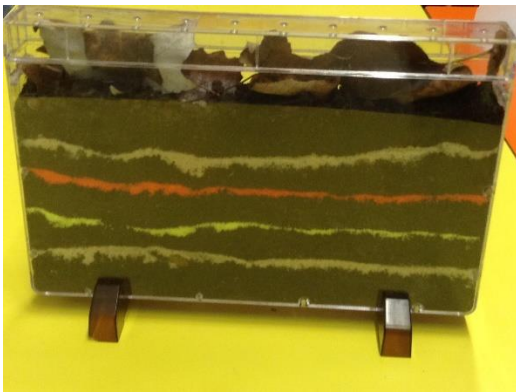

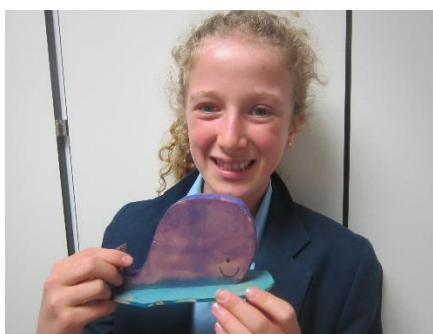
Year 6 Maths - CS
