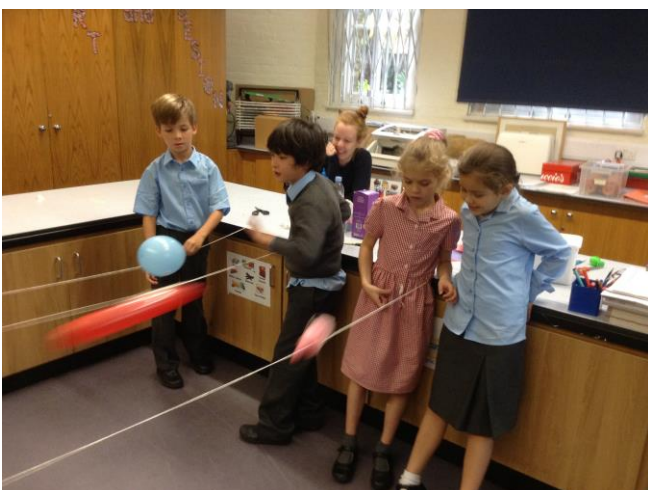


SCIENCE – MRS KELLY
