Noun – something that is done again or happens again

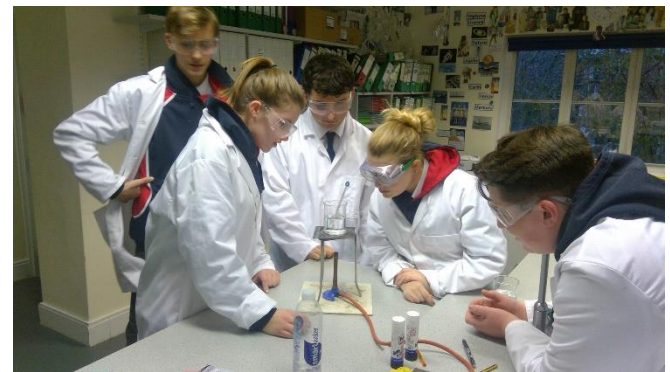
Sentence examples:
