Year 2 had a visit from Janine Nelson on Tuesday. Janine works at the garden museum and came to visit Year 2 during their Science lesson.

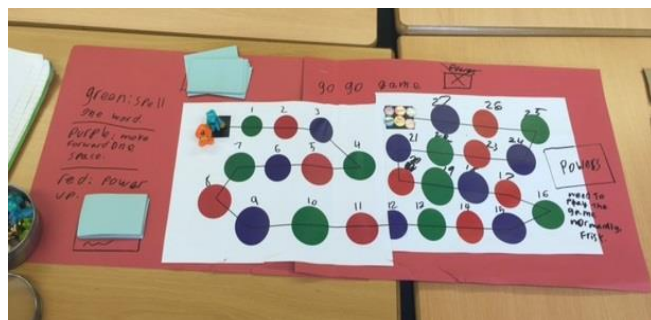
## GARDEN MUSEUM
