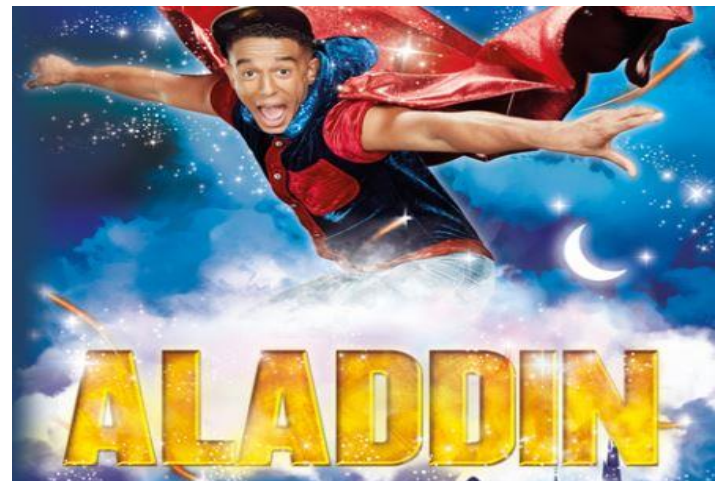
### ALADDIN – YEAR 6

## **What's been happening this week at Fairley House...**

### **ASSEMBLY AT LAMBETH ROAD**

During assembly on Friday morning, Lambeth Road children were introduced to the Fairley House School 'Brain Box'. Through little skits performed by different teachers, we learnt about the different ways in which our brain helps us such as memory, movement, organisation and self-regulation.



The children in Year 5 then went on to create their own Brain Box and reflected on what their brain does well and what they would like their brain to help them with more. The Year 4 pupils were very thoughtful and many children identified that their brain is very good at controlling movement, but not so good with remembering. The Year 2 and 3 pupils had a fun-filled lesson where they pulled things out of a spaghetti brain and discussed if they were good with these activities or needed help. We will continue to focus on these areas throughout the term so that the pupils being to develop good meta-cognitive strategies to support their learning.
