What was the conclusion to the story?

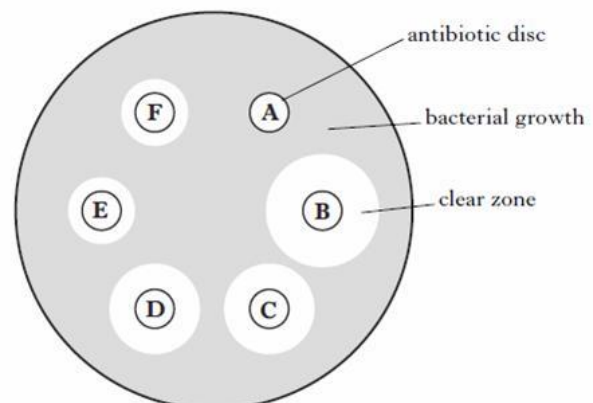


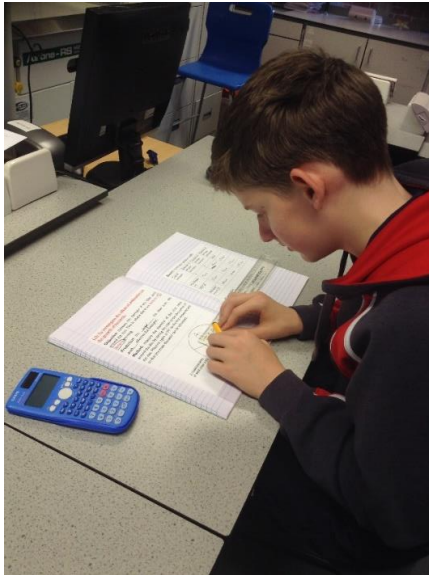

## CS - Y9 Science

The clear zone is used to determine whether a particular bacterium is susceptible to the action of a particular antibiotic or not. The testing for sensitivity of an organism to an antibiotic is usually done using agar diffusion or disk diffusion test. In this method, antibiotics are impregnated on a special type of paper disk and are placed on the surface of agar containing the bacterium of our interest. If the bacterium is sensitive to the particular antibiotic, no growth will be observed so the area around the disk will be clear and it is called as a clear zone. The larger the diameter of the clear zone, the more effective the antibiotic will be. That is what we have been testing this week by measuring the diameter of different samples. It has been the last topic of their Entry Level Certificate.
