Word of the Week: **Mindful**

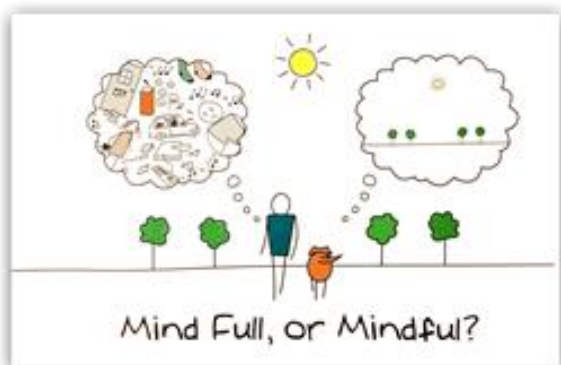
Definition:

Synonyms: thoughtful, aware, conscious,



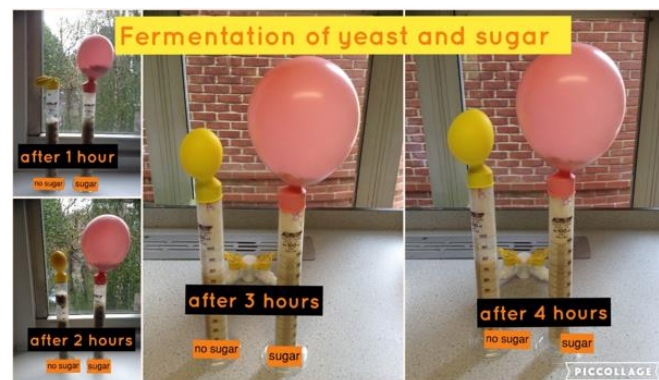

Y6 Spielberg (Science)

The week before half term, Y6 studied the process of fermentation to see how sugar affects the growth of yeast. Fermentation is a chemical process of breaking down a particular substance by microorganisms, in this case yeast. As the yeast eats sugar, it releases a gas called carbon dioxide. The gas fills the measuring cylinder and then fills the balloon as more gas is created.
