



On-line remote learning at Fairley House.

During current COVID-19 Restrictions, we continue to provide a comprehensive on-line programme to meet the learning needs of our children and young people via Microsoft Teams and our Virtual Learning Environment. This enables us to maintain face-to-face contact with our school community. All pupils are provided with a laptop to ensure they can access the on-line programme which covers all subjects. Learning takes place in small groups, as normal and is delivered by familiar specialist teachers to ensure continuity.

All possible measures are taken to ensure that provision within Education Health and Care Plans is delivered. Speech and Language Therapists and Occupational Therapists deliver individual and small group therapy on-line, also joining class groups for in-class provision. The I.T. team are also on-call to address any technology issues swiftly.

The emotional well-being of our children and young people is paramount; form tutors keep in touch via daily registration and form time and also in weekly PSHEE lessons. If a pupil needs extra support, this can be arranged flexibly and quickly, with close contact with parents.

Statutory Annual Reviews, Individual Education Plan and termly Parent Pupil Teacher meetings continue on-line along with Risk Assessments and close co-operation with Local Authorities and other agencies.
